FOOD HYGIENE NOTES FOR ALL STAFF

Beer and Cider are classed as foodstuffs, and therefore the provisions of the FOOD SAFETY ACT 1990 apply.

To ensure our compliance all staff are required to read the following notes and then sign to acknowledge.

- 1: If you have recently suffered from tummy bug, sickness, diarrhea or the like. Cold, sore throat or other ailment, please inform the Staffing Officer.
- 2: Hands, and in particular nails, must be kept clean. Always wash your hands after using the lavatory and after smoking, and before re-entering the bar area.
Wash your hands after blowing your nose or combing your hair and after cleaning up around the bar.
- 3: Staff must wear clean clothes.
- 4: While serving customers, staff must not:-
Eat, smoke, pick their noses, lick their fingers, sneeze in the beer. Finger spots, and boils, etc.
Put their fingers in glasses to be filled.
- 5: Cuts and abrasions must be covered with a blue waterproof dressing.
These are available from the cash office. A general first-aid kit is also kept there.
- 6: Please help to keep your bar clean. Spillage's, either on the bar top or the floor, should be dealt with at once, with clean cloths or mops. Empty bottles should be removed from the bar top and stored in boxes.

If you have any questions or problems, refer to the Staffing Officer or during the festival the manager in your designated area.
